In the event of exchange rate fluctuations, a US exchange rate set by Brewster will be applied when bookings are confirmed. Prices and information in this brochure are subject to change without notice. All prices include administration, planning and operational expenses.

BOOKINGS

For best tour selection, reservations should be made at least 45 days prior to departure. For bookings within 45 days, limited hotel or motorcoach space is available and may result in alternate vacation arrangements. At 45 days, we will begin checking package availability when we have a credit card for full payment on file.

PAYMENT/DEPOSIT
